

More Americans have died from Covid-19 than in all the country's wars combined.

The **COVID-19 pandemic in the United States** is a part of the <u>worldwide pandemic</u> of <u>coronavirus disease</u> <u>2019</u> (COVID-19) caused by <u>severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2</u> (SARS-CoV-2). In the United States, it has resulted in 82,468,606 confirmed cases with 1,000,000 all-time deaths, the most of any country, and <u>the nineteenth-highest</u> per capita worldwide. The COVID-19 pandemic ranks first on the <u>list of disasters in the United States by death toll</u>; it was the third-leading cause of death in the U.S. in 2020, behind heart disease and cancer. From 2019 to 2020, U.S. life expectancy dropped by 3 years for <u>Hispanic Americans</u>, 2.9 years for <u>African Americans</u>, and 1.2 years for <u>white Americans</u>. These effects have persisted as U.S. deaths due to COVID-19 in 2021 exceeded those in 2020.
